SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY:

The applicant must:

- Be an African-American female
- Be a graduating senior attending a Denver Metropolitan area High School
- Have a grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Have applied to an accredited four-year college or university.
- Not be a daughter of a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority

SELECTION:

Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria.

- **Financial Need:** Applicants must submit a valid, signed copy of their parents'/guardians' **IRS Form 1040 for the current year (2009)**. The IRS form must accompany the application.
- **Scholastic Record:** An official transcript, including GPA, class rank, and a copy of ACT or SAT scores must accompany the application.
- **Personal Statement/Essay:** The typed essay of at least 200 words should address personal goals, academic achievements and your plans toward making a difference in your community.
- **Recommendations:** Two letters of recommendation must be attached. One letter must be written by a teacher or educator and one letter should be written by a person familiar with the applicant's community service. Letters of recommendation should address why you are an ideal candidate for this scholarship.
- **Interview:** Applicants selected will be invited to interview with the scholarship committee.

THE APPLICATION DEADLINE IS APRIL 1

It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a completed application and all supporting documents in one package, postmarked by the deadline. No consideration will be given to incomplete or late applications.
